Who is this qualification for?

The ILM Level 3 is a first line management course which gives an introduction to the basic skills, knowledge, and understanding required by today's first line manager. This qualification is particularly suited to practising team leaders seeking to move up to the next level of management.

ILM Level 3 Award in Leadership and Management

To achieve the ILM Level 3 Award in Leadership and Management, you need a minimum total of 4 credits. Assignments and structured written questions will provide the evidence required to demonstrate a sound knowledge and understanding of the topics covered. The Level 3 consist of two modules and is delivered over 4 days and covers:

Understanding How to Motivate to Improve Performance (2 Credits)

- Basic theories of motivation and their application to teams and individuals
- Overview of the factors influencing behaviour at work
- Positive approaches to offset negative attitudes in the workplace

Solving Problems and Making Decisions (2 Credits)

- Ways to recognise, define, investigate and analyse problems
- Brainstorming, problem solving and creative thinking techniques
- Decision making techniques

ILM Level 3 Certificate in Leadership and Management

To achieve the ILM Level 3 Certificate in Leadership and Management, you need a minimum total of 13 credits. The Level 3 Certificate consists of 7 modules and is delivered over 10 days covering:

- Understanding how to motivate to improve performance (2 Credits)
- Understanding leadership (2 Credits)
- Solving problems and making decisions (2 Credits)
- Giving briefings and making presentations (2 Credits)

- Planning change in the workplace (2 Credits)
